giving up the conveniences we so appreciate. At the Cutoff, you will find a refreshing change from overcrowded, highly regulated venues. A place which is ideal for families & large gatherings is within minutes of Custer State Park, Mt. Rushmore, Crazy Horse & much more.

South Dakota is often referred to as God's country, so traditional values dominate; guns, less government & personal responsibility are part of the culture you'll find when you visit.

Location: 5 miles from downtown Custer (2 miles gravel & 3 miles paved road) with ATM/bank, groceries, laundromat, hospital, massage therapist, drug store / pharmacy & 6 major hotel chains.

Accommodations: This peaceful & private 10.87 acres is perfect for camping, family venues, RV-ing & equestrian camping & is pet friendly.

The rolling windswept meadows & pastures are bordered by the

National Forest & French Creek, which can be panned for gold or go fishing as it is stocked with trout. Wildlife is abundant &

makes daily debuts. The property has continuous pipe fencing with gated entrances in all four corners allowing easy access. The main entrance is accommodating to the largest of rigs, (campers, living quarters horse trailers, 5th wheels, pull behind - pop up's & RV's.) There are 12 sites all with water hook up, 50/30 & 110 amp with drive through dump station. There are two automatic

watering posts for horses & five water hydrants with a hose network, making water usage a breeze. There are two porta-potties & one handicap full bathroom, eight outdoor bath tubs, two showers & sauna. A complete summer kitchen, out & indoor grills, picnic pavilion, laundry services, an activity studio,

topped off with high speed internet/WiFi throughout the entire property. **Equines:** In two locations are 8 stalls. Each stall area has ample turn outs with paddocks ranging in size from 1/3 acre to 2+ acres. A round pen

The Studio is a 30'x 40' monitor style building that highlights; Post & Beam construction, with a balcony that overlooks the French Creek to the east & a covered porch to the west. This is a place for relaxation, fitness, gatherings & the healthy healing of mind, body & soul. Games, cards, puzzles, books, movies, music, yoga & any other indoor celebrations / activities are possible. A foosball & ping pong table, along with a video & sound system with a dazzling disco ball w/ seating for 50.

A-Frame Cabin rustic and friendly is fully furnished. It is unique in size & style. This single room has electricity, heater, fan, privacy,



DVD/TV, mini frig, electric burner with toaster oven & supplies. Sleeps 6 with loft in two full/double beds & two twin/single beds. *The sauna, cowboy & outside shower along with the full kitchen in the Pavilion are proprietary to Cabin & Sleeping Loft guests.*

The Loft is attached to the B&B Dome has a private stairway entrance. The loft lives up to its name with sleeping for 7. This open room has two queen beds, a Murphy & Trundle, & 3 additional twin/single trundle beds. A large dressing room closet, seat, a TV, DVD & mini frig. A half bathroom is located under the stairs. *The sauna, cowboy & outside shower, along with the full kitchen in the Pavilion are proprietary to Cabin & Sleeping Loft guests.*

The Meadow View Dome House: This beautiful gem with magnificent uninterrupted views is tops. A polished concrete floor on the main level & hickory wood and tile on

the second, gives this dome that extra punch. The main level is handicap accessible with 2 roll-in entrances & shower. The kitchen has state of the art appliances including: an induction stove, exhaust fan, air make-up system, dish washer, garbage disposal, oven, microwave & smaller electric appliances. The Dome house has a washer, dryer, 2 showers & one tub. Has 2 bedrooms each with a King bed, white linens and towels provided. Has 4 smart Samsung TV's and high speed Wi-Fi home



Meals: Guests provide their own meals unless B & B or other catering arrangements are made.

Details: All dogs must be pack-friendly –

no leash requirement. Level ground, park anywhere you want, no certified hay required. Few bugs & low humidity (however, bring bug spray/mask for gnats). Front shoes or boots strongly recommended for horses, if not all the way around. Hundreds of miles of National & State trails for riding/biking/4 wheeling with numerous loop trails back to property. Every night temperature drops below 65 degrees – day's range

from 69 to 93 degrees with hail possible







Lastly the Custer Park wildlife loop. 40 minutes to: Bear Country USA, Reptile Gardens & The town of Rockerville with the Hippie hole (Take 16 north to Rapid, east on Rockerville Rd., & go 3 miles to Foster Gulch - follow #372) a great adventure with cliff jumping & water fall. The town of Deadwood (Gambling, bars & history), and Rapid City where the Journey, Grand River museums are & loads more. 1-2 hours to: Ellsworth Air & Space museum, Sturgis, Deadwood, Wall Drug & the Bad Lands. 2.5 hours to: Devils Tower & the Big Horn Mountains in WY. 


